White Merlot Wine

(generally speaking:)

White Merlot wine is not so commonly found in the wine industry. Often it is put in the same category as a White Zinfandel or Blush Zinfandel, or even a Rose' (similar, though not).

A true White Merlot is made almost exclusively from Merlot grapes while usually possessing a 'blush' or 'rosy' pinkish hue in contrast to the ruby color of a traditional Merlot.

White Merlot is often served chilled though I prefer it at room temperature as it brings out more of its flavor nuances.

White Merlots vary from sweet to semi-sweet to even somewhat dry. They get their diluted color by reducing the amount of time that the grape juice is in contact with the red skins of the Merlot grapes.

White Merlot wines became a near instant hit in France with consumers and is now a renown favorite.

Most White Merlots are not vintage wines, though ours is, 2008.

They can be enjoyed with a wide variety of foods, for those more appreciative of white wines as contrary to big reds.
